

Installation instructions

1. Deploy SSM parameters.

Conditional. If you already have SSM parameters in place, skip this step.

Deploy the CloudFormation template `cfn/ssm.template`. It may be easiest to do this from the AWS console as there are a lot of parameters to configure.

2. Install code dependencies

```
cd src/trigger  
npm i
```

```
cd src/pca  
pip install -t . -r requirements.txt
```

3. Create the FFMPEG Lambda layer

```
mkdir layer  
cd layer  
mkdir bin  
curl https://johnvansickle.com/ffmpeg/releases/ffmpeg-release-amd64-  
static.tar.xz | tar Jx  
mv ffmpeg*/ffmpeg ffmpeg*/ffprobe bin  
zip -vr ffmpeg.zip bin -x
```

This results in a file called `ffmpeg.zip`, which you should upload to the S3 bucket defined in the configuration parameter `SupportFilesBucketName`.

4. Deploy the PCA solution.

This must be done from the command line.

```
cd cfn  
  
aws cloudformation package \  
  --template-file main.template \  
  --output-template-file packaged.template \  
  --s3-bucket <bucket>  
  
aws cloudformation deploy \  
  --template-file packaged.template \  
  --stack-name <stack> \  
  --capabilities CAPABILITY_NAMED_IAM CAPABILITY_AUTO_EXPAND
```

Replace the following values in the above invocations:

Name	Value
<bucket>	Name of an S3 bucket that will hold packaged lambda code during deployment
<stack>	Desired name of the CloudFormation stack
